

Eligibility

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the Honours Course, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/ Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject “ Environmental Science” is studied as an Elective Subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

A) A candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained:

i) A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject in the previous qualifying examination

OR

ii) 55% marks in the subject or related subject in the previous qualifying examination

OR

iii) 50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his / her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

B) However, candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe Community taking up Honours Course of study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subject in the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

C) Students who have passed the H.S. (10 + 2) examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards / Councils [i.e. CBSE, ISC, and National Institute of Open Schooling] need not require submitting the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

D) Candidates who have passed H.S. examinations in 2012 to 2017 are eligible for admission.

E) Candidates must pass in English of full marks 100.

F) Candidates seeking admission must secure a minimum of 21 out of 70 in theory and a minimum of 9 out of 30 in practical examinations in Physics, Chemistry, Biology etc. in the previous qualifying examinations. For Mathematics, minimum marks in theory is 24 out of 80 and minimum marks in Project is 6 out of 20.

G) Candidates seeking admission with Honours in Physics must pass in Physics & Mathematics and those seeking admission with Honours in Chemistry must pass in Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics.

H) Candidates seeking admission with Hons. In Economics must pass in Mathematics at the H.S. level [10 +2] conducted by WBCHSE or its equivalent in Mathematics or Business Math. Candidates who have passed in Business Economics including Business Math. in H.S. [10 +2] are also eligible.

I) Candidates who have passed the H.S. [10 +2] Vocational Examination conducted by WBSCVET are eligible for admission to B.A. (General) only with subjects in the Humanities Division.

J) A candidate will be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading "A" if he / she had passed the subject(s) under heading "B" at the previous qualifying examination:
